#### **CEA Antitrust Statement**

The purpose of the CEA is to explore avenues of mutual interest and cooperation in building energy policy. It is important to recognize that these activities are subject to certain legal limits imposed by state and federal antitrust laws. One central concern of these laws is with combinations or agreements in restraint of trade whereby competition is reduced by design. In the course of all CEA activities, discussions among members involving pricing, sale terms, territories, production or other aspects of competition, must be avoided. In the event any member ever feels that the course of Alliance activities or statements or actions in Alliance meetings is headed into such an area, members should raise the issue immediately so that further discussion of such matters can be suspended pending receipt of advice satisfactory to the members that the topics addressed do not give rise to antitrust problems.

#### 2025 Code Cycle Updates

- 2025 Code Development Updates & Next Steps
  - o Timeline:
    - May/June 2023 Draft to CEC for feedback, then post to Docket
    - July 2023 Final Draft Proposals due
    - October 2023 Draft language (pre-45 day language) finalized by CEC
    - January 2024 45-day language released by CEC
    - June 2024 adopt Building Energy Efficiency Standards by CEC
    - December 2024 Building Standards Commission adopts Title 24
  - CEA Measures
    - CEA draft proposals
      - Mandatory Monitoring
      - Fault Detection & Diagnostics
      - Multilevel Lighting Controls
    - Reached out to stakeholders for cost data/papers & market analysis
    - Complete cost-effectiveness analysis and stateside energy impacts



#### **CASE Team Collaboration**

- 2025 Cycle CASE Reports <u>link to reports</u>
  - HVAC Controls: Guideline 36
    - Title 24 includes aggressive HVAC controls requirements, but they have not been realized
      often enough in practice. Rather than placing the burden on designers and installers,
      ASHRAE Guideline 36 moves the process "upstream" to the manufacturer level where the
      controls are programmed into equipment and savings are automatically realized.
    - ASHRAE Guideline 36 provides peer-reviewed sequences of operation for HVAC systems, written in a format that can be readily implemented by building controls manufacturers and control system contractors.
    - Provide feedback by May 30th
